Growing wildflowers encourages beneficial insects and wildlife above and below the ground helping to create a diverse and complex eco-system, which in turn helps grow healthy vines and grapes with a natural resilience. This is the basis of sustainable and organic grape growing, maximising nature's own strengths by managing our practices to ensure a pristine growing environment.

WINERY

The juice for this wine is given around two hours of skin contact to achieve light colour, before being pressed, settled and fermented in the same way we normally make our white wines. The wine was aged on lees for a few months to increase the palate richness and balance. Before being lightly fined and filtered.

TASTE

This dry style of Rosé is made to be enjoyed day or night, with food or without. Lifted aromas of stone fruit, rockmelon, watermelon and floral characters lead to a flavour-packed palate that is refreshing and succulent with a hint of sweetness, beautifully balanced by bright acidity.
